SUBJECT: June 15, 2005 Basic Calculation for Equalization Assistance Report (CHAR 55-1) and Equalization Assistance Detail Report (CHAR 64-1)

The June 2005 charter apportionment is complete. All eligible charter schools were paid based on 100th day ADM data that was *received* and *processed* by 5:00 pm on May 31st, 2005. The equalization assistance reports (CHAR55-1 and CHAR64-1) for your charter school are posted on your charter school's home page on the ADE School Finance web site at <http://www.ade.az.gov/districts>. If you need help finding or viewing these reports please contact your local Regional Training Center (<http://www.ade.az.gov/rtc>).

In the event that you did not receive a June 2005 payment, or if your payment is significantly less than your prior months payments this may be due to:

- Missing or late submission of 100th day ADM data.
- Adjustments made due to changes in 40th or 100th day ADM data (for example, adjustments made due to over-estimated ADMS counts).
- Missing or changes in SPED or ELL data (see your SPED28-1 and ELLS10-1 reports).

Please be sure to view the State Aid Requirements Checklist. Your charter will not be eligible to receive any FY2005-06 Charter School Equalization payments unless ADE, School Finance has received all required items, from your charter, prior to the June 21st, 2005 due date.

All charter schools, regardless of sponsorship, must submit all student detail data to ADE using an approved electronic format for each charter site. It is the responsibility of each charter school to verify that the ADMS46-1 and if applicable, the SPED28-1 and ELLS10-1 reports accurately reflects the data submitted. Please see the "Student Detail Activity Report" at <http://www.ade.az.gov/schoolfinance/BulletinBoard/ActivityRpt.pdf> for aggregation and report dates through the end of the fiscal year.
