SUBJECT: FY2008 County Jail Education Program

Arizona Revised Statute Title §15-913.01 requires each county that operates a county jail to offer an education program to serve all eligible prisoners. Eligible prisoners are defined as:

- prisoners who have been in the county jail for more than forty-eight hours
- have received at least two hundred forty minutes of instruction per day
- are under the age of eighteen years
- or prisoners with disabilities who are age twenty-one or younger

Pursuant to statute, the county school superintendent may establish a county jail education fund to provide financial support to the jail education program. This fund shall consist of a base amount set at \$14,400 and a variable amount that is calculated based on the submittal of your instructional days for 2008 and the FY2009 Base Level Amount (BLA) of \$3,291.42.

In order to calculate the total amount of State Aid to your County Educational Program for FY2009, the following information must be submitted to the Arizona Department of Education by August 15, 2008.
