Re: Non-Formula Reductions

Dear Superintendents and Charter Holders:

Pursuant to <u>Chapter 12 House Bill 2643</u>, 1st <u>Regular Session</u>, 49th <u>Legislature</u>, requires the Department of Education to cut thirteen million dollars from non-formula line items. Last fiscal year, Superintendent Horne, implemented the FY 2009 lump sum reductions without having any significant impact on schools. However, this year there is no way to implement these cuts without impacting the non-formula funding to schools. To provide as much information as possible I have listed below general fund programs that will have reductions this year:

- 1. AIMs Intervention & Dropout Preventing
- 2. Adult Education
- 3. Chemical Abuse
- 4. Early Childhood State Block Grant
- 5. Family Literacy
- 6. Gifted Support
- 7. School Safety Program
- 8. Optional Performance Incentive Program
- 9. Parental Choice for Reading Success
