Subject : FY 2012 NCLB Consolidation Application / Allocation List

All LEAs will be able to review their fiscal 2012 Title I and Title II allocations at <http://www.ade.az.gov/asd/>. Apply for these funds using the NCLB Consolidated Application. LEAs reporting neglected or delinquent student counts from October of 2010 will receive a separate allocation notice. There are no additional ARRA allocations. LEAs must file a completion report for FY11 Title I ARRA funds to determine the amount of carryover available.

The information used to determine these allocations came from census data provided by the U.S. ED and NCLB Eligibility counts as provided in the Student Information Accountability System (SAIS). **Please note that failure to enter the correct information into the SAIS system may have resulted in incorrect allocation amounts and could result in an incorrect AYP determination.** Before allocations can be adjusted, the correct information will need to be input into SAIS so that proper determinations, i.e. allocations, AYP, etc., can be made.

Any LEA not in compliance with certain program and/or fiscal requirements of the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 and/or the governing regulations may receive an allocation but will not be able to draw down funds until the out of compliance conditions are corrected. Out of compliance conditions include, but are not limited to the following:

1. Failure to submit a Consolidated State Performance Report as required
2. Failure to maintain effort as determined by School Finance
3. Failure to complete the LEA Consolidated Plan as required
4. Failure to submit documents for the 6-Cycle Monitoring,
5. Failure to provide NCLB indicator I and or Indicator II data in SAIS as required, or
6. Failure to submit any other program reports when due, e.g., comparability assurances, audit resolution documents, private school consultation forms, constitutionally protected prayer certifications, etc.

All LEAs intending to apply for the NCLB programs contained in the NCLB Consolidated Application need to submit a substantially approvable application as soon as possible. Per 34 CFR 76.708 sub-grantees of formula, grant programs such as those contained in the NCLB Consolidated Application may NOT OBLIGATE funds before a substantially approvable application is completed. The capacity of the LEA to reimburse obligations to these programs incurred prior to the submission of the NCLB Consolidated Application is subject to approval by ADE.
